The Championship will consist of a 36 hole qualifying round played over one day. All ties will be decided on the last 18 holes; if a further tie results, will be decided on the last 9, 6, 3 or 1 hole(s)

If you are eligible for the Junior Prize (U 18 on 1st Jan 2012) or intermediate trophy (age 18 to 25 on 1st Jan 2012) please indicate on entry forms by writing (JUN) or (INT) after date of birth.

The County shield: Each county shall nominate four players to represent it in the County Shield. From these four, the lowest aggregate scratch scores returned over the 36 shall count. The nominated players must be members of that County association in the Midlands South Region. In the event of low entry numbers the Championship Committee may agree a selection of three nominated players.

Practice rounds. Please contact The Warwickshire Golf and Country Club (01926 622570) to arrange tee times. It is hoped that the club will be able to accommodate some free practice rounds on Wednesday 18th July mid to late afternoon. Outside this period, practice rounds will be charged at member's guest fee rates.

In the event of entries exceeding 60, the players with the lowest exact handicaps will be accepted. The exact handicap at the closing date will be used for the purposes of the ballot. - No entry fee will be returned after the closing date.
- Players may not engage a Professional or assistant Professional as a caddy
- A current Active CONGU Handicap Certificate must be produced on the day
- The EWGA Equality and Equal Opportunity, Gender, Transportation (use of buggies) and anti-doping policies apply to all competitions in this Championship. Compliance is the responsibility of the competitor. These policies can be found on the EWGA web site.
- All juniors (under 18) must or bring with them a completed parental consent form. Please request a form where required.
- A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.
