CONDITIONS / QUALIFICATIONS AND FURTHER INFORMATION:

- 1 The competition will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf, as approved by the R & A of St Andrews and with the Local Rules of the Club.
- 2 All players shall have amateur status in accordance with the current Amateur Status Regulations of the R & A of St Andrews.
- 3 All players shall be full members of a County Association within the Midlands South Region
- 4 Substitutions will be allowed after closing date at the discretion of the Organiser.
- 5 An up to date ACTIVE CONGU handicap certificate which shows the player's CDH ID number, must be produced when checking in
- 6 A competitor shall not knowingly make use of any drugs to enhance performance. A list of Prohibited drugs is available from the EWGA office. Penalty for breach of rules is disqualification
- 7 Competitors must not engage a professional or assistant professional as a caddy. Penalty for breach of rules is disqualification
- 8 The ball must conform to the list issued by the R & A
- 9 Driving clubs must conform to the list issued by the R & A
- 10 Players shall walk at all times unless permitted to ride by the organising committee, on production of a current medical certificate. (Refer to EWGA Transportation Policy.)
- 11 A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature etc) the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.
- 12 The competition shall consist of **18 hole Medal play Better Ball off $\frac{3}{4}$ handicap** from the EWGA Medal Tees. **Maximum individual handicap of 24.** There shall be a limit of 80 couples with preference given to lowest combined pairs if oversubscribed.
- 13 In the event of inclement weather, the Organiser reserves the right to decide over how many holes the competition is played and how the prizes are awarded.
- 14 **Trophies & Prizes:**
Trophies and prizes will be awarded for the best 18 hole scratch and nett better ball scores. No pair may win more than one prize.
- 15 Money will not be refunded after the draw has been made, unless places can be filled from a waiting list.
- 16 Players aged under 18 years must produce a copy of their current Parental Consent Form.
