CONDITIONS / QUALIFICATIONS AND FURTHER INFORMATION:

The Championship shall consist of two 18-hole stroke play rounds played over one day, for which one draw will be made. All ties shall be decided on last 18,9,6,3 or 1 hole.

The Midlands South Girls' Championship shall be open to female golfers who are Under 18 years of age on the 1 January 2012; who are members of a recognised golf club within Midlands South Region; who have Amateur Status in accordance with the current Amateur Status Rules of the R&A Rules Limited and who hold a CONGU Exact Handicap of not more than 20.4 at date of entry.

All entry forms must be returned with a completed Parental Consent Form. Entry forms submitted without the Parental Consent Form will not be accepted.

Entries shall be limited to 64. In the event of entries exceeding this number, the 64 players with the lowest Exact Handicaps will be accepted. In the event of a tie, the 64th place shall be decided by a ballot, which shall take place immediately after the closing date for entries. Those entrants balloted out will be placed on a waiting list. Unsuccessful entrants will have their entry fees refunded. No entry fee will be returned after the closing date.

A current Active CONGU Handicap Certificate must be produced on the day.

Caddies/Trolley Pullers are NOT permitted.

A player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.

Only competitors are allowed on the fairways. Spectators (including parents, guardians and relatives) and County officials must walk to the side of the fairways and must not advise or influence any of the players.

The EWGA Equity and Equal Opportunity, Gender, Transportation (use of buggies) and Anti-Doping policies apply to all competitors in this Championship. Compliance is the responsibility of the competitor. These policies can be found on the EGU website www.englishwomensgolf.org

In the event of adverse conditions, the organisers reserve the right to alter the format of the competition in order to achieve a result. The organising Committee reserves the right to arrange and/or alter starting times. In all matters, the decision of the organising Committee is final.
